

PATIENTS MEETING ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING ARE NALOXONE CANDIDATES:

- Any OUD treatment
- Any history of overdose
- Any substance use diagnosis
- Discharge opioid Rx with
 - Alcohol use disorder diagnosis
 - Psychiatric diagnosis
 - Benzodiazepine Rx
- Any opioid over 50 MME
 - See reverse for MME calculation chart

Calculating MMEs

- 1 Determine total daily amount of each opioid taken
- 2 Convert to MME by multiplying daily dose by the conversion factor in the chart below

Opioid	Conversion Factor	Daily Dose = 50 MME
(in mg, except where noted)		
Codeine	0.15	330
Fentanyl patch (in mCg/hr)	2.4	20 mCg/hr
Hydrocodone	1	50
Hydromorphone oral	4	12.5
Morphine oral	1	50
Tramadol	0.25	200
Oxycodone	1.5	30
Oxymorphone	3	15

** These dose conversions are estimated and cannot account for all individual differences in genetics and pharmacokinetics

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
